The following information was provided to ISSC:

FDA was notified by the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) through the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services (NVDHHS) of two clusters of illnesses from individuals that consumed raw oysters from a single source at a restaurant in Las Vegas on 10/28/2022 and 11/5/2022. To date, SNHD reports nine potential sapovirus illnesses and one confirmed through stool sample.

Traceback information revealed a single source for implicated oysters from shipment by Dai One Food Co., Republic of Korea, to Aqua Royale Foods, Inc. (Paramus, NJ), who in turn shipped to dealers in Nevada, New York, New Jersey, and Georgia. Investigation is ongoing and implicates frozen, half-shell oysters from the original dealer, Dai One Food Co., Ltd. (KR 8 SP) from Designated Area II with a harvest date of February 6, 2022.
