Dear Secretary Haddaway-Riccio:

The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has been notified by the Maryland Department of Health of an illness outbreak in Virginia, where the sources identified may have been oysters harvested from St. George's Creek, St. Mary's River in St. Mary's County. Currently, a thorough investigation is underway to determine the source of illness. As a precaution and to meet the strict requirements under the National Shellfish Sanitation Program, MDE is required to close the implicated area at least until the investigation is complete.

Therefore, pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, Natural Resources Article § 4-742 (2005 Replacement Volume), and effective November 13, 2021, MDE hereby closes the area described below for the harvesting or storing of shellfish until further notice.

## ST. GEORGE CREEK, ST. MARY'S RIVER, ST. MARY'S COUNTY

Due to illness outbreak that occurred since the harvest of oysters on November 1, 2021, the Department has issued an emergency closure to:

All the waters of St. George Creek, St. Mary's River downstream from a line extending in an easterly direction from Hodgson Point (38°08'45.3" North Latitude, 76°30'09.0" West Longitude) near St. George Island directly across to Tarkill Point (38°08'44.5" North Latitude, 76°29'42.0" West Longitude) on the opposite shore, and all of the waters upstream of a line extending in a northeasterly direction from Russel Point (38°07'11.8" North Latitude, 76°28'15.4" West Longitude) on St. George Island to Cherry Field Point (38°07'44.5" North Latitude, 76°28'00.7" West Longitude) on the opposite shore.

The closure is necessary to protect public health and will remain in effect until further notice.


