CDPH Environmental Management Branch has received laboratory results from the Food and Drug Laboratory reporting that the oyster meats collected on January 4th, 2019 from Leases M-430-10, M-430-11, and M-430-12 were negative for norovirus. CDPH is therefore lifting the illness closure for Tomales Bay as of today January 17, 2019 at 12:49 PM.

All Tomales Bay growing areas remain closed to harvest due to rainfall.
