

Washington State Closure and Recall

The ISSC was notified today of a closure and recall associated with levels of PSP. It appears from the list below that all of the product has been contained and will be disposed of appropriately. The harvest area was Henderson Bay and the distribution was as listed below:

- A. Southern California
Total of 1554 dozen oysters. All of the product has been contained.
- B. Hong Kong
Total of 293 dozen oysters. All of the product will be destroyed upon arrival.
- C. Seattle
Total of 147 dozen oysters. All of the product has been contained.
- D. Seattle
Total of 575 dozen oysters. All of the product has been contained
- E. Taiwan
Total of 113 dozen oysters. All of the product will be disposed.
- F. Salt Lake City
Total of 10 dozen oysters. All of the product will be disposed.
- G. Boise
Total of 40 dozen oysters. All of the product will be disposed.
- H. Alaska
Total of 80 dozen oysters. All of the product will be disposed.
- I. Portland
Total of 25 dozen oysters. All of the product will be disposed.
