
**RESCISSION OF EMERGENCY DESIGNATION OF SHELLFISH LANDS
IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK
AS UNCERTIFIED FOR THE HARVEST OF SHELLFISH**

Pursuant to the provisions of Subdivisions 13-0307 (1) and (2) and Subdivision 13-0309 (1) of the Environmental Conservation Law and Sections 42.17 and 47.4 of Title 6 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, and based on no additional reports of shellfish related foodborne illnesses caused by *Vibrio parahaemolyticus* linked to New York State shellfish harvest area NS3, I, James J. Gilmore, Bureau Chief of Marine Resources, Division of Fish, Wildlife & Marine Resources of the Department of Environmental Conservation, hereby partially rescind the designation of shellfish lands as uncertified for the harvest of shellfish dated September 4, 2014. **This order is effective at sunrise on Friday, September 19, 2014. Accordingly, the harvest of shellfish, including hard clams and oysters, from the following area is permitted:**

Town of Huntington: All the normally certified shellfish lands in Northport Bay, Centerport Harbor, Duck Island Harbor, Lloyd Harbor and Huntington Bay.
