
REOPENING OF MOLLUSCAN SHELLFISH WATERS IN LOUISIANA

Pursuant to the provisions of LSA R.S. 40:5.3 as amended and re-enacted by Act 1 of the First Regular Legislative Session of 1988, and R.S. 40:5, the Precautionary Closure Order of molluscan shellfish waters in Louisiana effective dated August 28, 2012 is hereby rescinded.

Molluscan shellfish growing areas located in Shellfish Harvest areas 19, 21 and 23 shall revert to their current September-October seasonal classification status effective one-half hour prior to official sunrise, September 8, 2012.

This order effective one half hour before official sunrise, September 8, 2012.




