<b>Specific NSSP Guide Reference</b>	ISSC Constitution, Bylaws, and Procedures, Article IV. Section 7.
<b>Text of Proposal/ Requested Action</b>	<p>To accomplish the intent of the Constitution it is necessary to elect approximately ½ of the Board to four-year terms. After the 2005 election all Board members will be elected to four-year terms. In 2005 (odd or even) regions will be elected to four-year terms with the remaining elected to (two-year or four-year) terms.</p> <p>ISSC Constitution Article IV. Executive Board, Officers, Committees Section 7.</p> <p>Elected Board members shall serve <del>two</del> <b>four-year</b> terms. Terms of the elected Board members shall expire at the end of the voting General Assembly of the regular Biennial Conference meeting.</p>

<b>Action by 2005 Task Force III</b>	Recommended adoption of Proposal 05-300 as submitted. In addition, requests the Executive Board to consider whether Board Officer terms should be addressed.

<b>Action by ISSC Executive Board August 19, 2005</b>	Recommended consideration of Proposal 05-300 at the March 2006 Executive Board meeting.

<b>Action by 2007 Executive Board</b>	Recommends no further action on Proposal 05-300. Rationale – Conducting Board Officer elections every two years does not create concern for the Executive Board.

<b>Action by 2007 General Assembly</b>	Adopted recommendation of 2007 Task Force III.
