
PARTIAL REOPENING
OF
MOLLUSCAN SHELLFISH WATERS IN LOUISIANA

Pursuant to the provisions of LSA R.S. 40:5.3 as amended and re-enacted by Act 1 of the First Regular Legislative Session of 1988, and R.S. 40:5, the Precautionary Closure Order of molluscan shellfish waters in Louisiana effective dated May 23, 2010 is hereby rescinded.

Molluscan shellfish growing area located in Shellfish Harvest Area 10 (East Bank of Grand Bayou at latitude 29.17'58" N and longitude 89.40'46" W extending to near Shell Island Bay at latitude 29.16'53" N and longitude 89.36'17" W) shall revert back to May - August Classification effective one-half hour prior to official sunrise, Tuesday, June 29, 2010.

This order effective one half hour before official sunrise, June 29, 2010.
