Findings/Conclusions:

Changing the wording to "maintained" would require constant monitoring. Pre-chilled trucks have chilled walls that help quickly lower temperatures when doors are opened and closed.

Recommendations:

The Committee recommends no action on Proposal 19-220. Rationale: This is adequately addressed in the Model Ordinance.

Charge 3: Proposal 19-231: Addition of shipping CCP.

Findings/Conclusions:

The proposed language would transfer HACCP responsibilities from the dealer to the shipper. There is no means to track the shipment that would guarantee shellfish has been held at an adequate temperature.

Recommendations:

The Committee recommends no action on Proposal 19-231. Rationale : This is adequately addressed in the Model Ordinance.
