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**Charges**

**Charge 1: Annually review trends in Vibrio illnesses and propose recommendations for addressing illnesses associated with vibrios.**

Findings/Conclusions: Reviewed the most recent report from the Vibrio vulnificus Illness Review Committee. The committee supports the timely delivery of illness data to be reviewed by committee.

Recommendations: No committee recommendation.

**Charge 2: Proposal 19-241: Vibrio vulnificus risk evaluation.**

Findings/Conclusions: Amended proposal to:

Revise indicators for severe illness.

- Avoid counting cases that might potentially have severe disease as a result of exposure to contaminated water or handling raw seafood.
- Avoid language that counts cases of Vv gastroenteritis.

Add language that new criteria will be implemented beginning with 2016 illness data.

Add hard shell clams.

Make minor editorial changes.

Remove septicemia to replace with severe.

Recommendations: Committee recommends adoption of proposal 19-241 as amended with effective implementation date of March 24, 2023.

**Charge 3: Proposal 19-200: Impact of Water Quality in Wet Storage**

Findings/Conclusions: Science or data is lacking to support. Proposal is premature and doesn't address specific changes to model ordinance.

Recommendations: Committee recommends no action.
