

The ISSC received the following information on February 28, 2020

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency has advised the FDA of two recalls due to possible norovirus. The first is Union Bay Seafood Ltd. is recalling certain Union Bay Seafood Ltd. brand Pacific Oysters. The harvest area implicated is BC 14-8, landfile #1402060. The harvest date of the implicated product is February 10, 2020. Implicated products include Pacific Oysters, Chef Creek Xsm; Pacific Oysters, Cascadia Xsm; Pacific Oysters, Royal Miyagi Xsm. The size for all three products is 5 dozen. The implicated lot number W20200211, is the same for all three products. This recall date is February 27, 2020. At this time, it is believed distribution in the United States has been limited to one (1) firm in California. The second reported recall involves Sawmill Bay Shellfish Co. Ltd. They are recalling certain Sawmill Bay Shellfish brand Pacific Aquacultured Oysters from the marketplace due to norovirus. The sizes are by the dozen (Lots: 453 and 454) and variable count packages (no lot numbers; however, dates span from February 12-19, 2020). This recall date is February 22, 2020. There is no harvest area information for this recall at this time. Currently, it is believed distribution in the United States has been limited to one (1) firm in Hawaii.
