

The following information was provided to ISSC:

Washington State is in the process of conducting a recall of geoduck harvested from the Samish Bay growing area in Skagit County, WA. All geoduck harvested from June 6th through today are being recalled due to high levels of PSP detected in samples. Washington's action level for closure is 80 micrograms. The lab results indicated 86 micrograms.

919 pounds of geoduck were harvested by Taylor Shellfish, WA-0046-SP and exported by Air Sky Inc DBA Wei San Ocean Sky, WA-1667-SS to one buyer in China.
