

The following information was provided to ISSC:

Washington State is in the process of conducting a recall of oyster shellstock harvested from the Kilisut Harbor growing area in Jefferson County, WA. All oysters harvested from July 18th through today are being recalled due to high levels of PSP detected in samples. Our action level for closure is 80 micrograms. The lab results indicated 98 micrograms.

Affected oysters were shipped by Hama Hama Company WA-0259-SP to the following locations:

1. The Dutch (Nashville, TN) - 25 dz - received and destroyed.
2. Shuck Oyster Bar (Costa Mesa, CA) - 10 dz - delayed in transit, working on destroying with FedEx - restaurant has been notified and will destroy upon arrival.
3. Seminole Hardrock (Hollywood, FL) - 50 dz - received and destroyed.

It is believed these locations are the only ones affected by the recall. Please contact us if you have any questions.
