

The following information was provided to ISSC:

Washington State is in the process of conducting a recall of Littleneck and Manilla clams harvested from the conditionally approved area of the Annas Bay growing area in Mason County, WA. All clams harvested on 10/30/2022 and 10/31/2022 are being recalled due to the Skokomish River rising during a rainfall event.

Washington State is working to gather exact quantities of product affected and disposition of that product from harvesters in the area. Affected product was shipped to Alaska, Oregon, Florida, and Idaho. At least 700 pounds of product was harvested from this growing area on the night of 10/30 and into the morning of 10/31.

Washington State is waiting for distribution details from the shellfish companies.
