Requested Action	(1) Except for any shellstock included in the Authority's commingling plan, the Authority shall not permit the commingling of shellstock. (2) If the Authority permits shellstock commingling, the Authority shall develop a commingling management plan. The plan shall: (a) Minimize the commingling dates of harvest and growing areas; (b) Define a primary dealer; (c) Limit the practice of commingling to primary dealers; (d) Limit commingling to shellstock harvested from specific growing areas within the State as identified by the Authority and purchased directly from harvesters; and (e) Define how the commingled shellstock will be identified. (3). The Authority shall not permit the commingling of in-shell product.
Public Health Significance:	There is currently no restriction on commingling of in-shell product in the Model Ordinance. The proposed change provides such a restriction.
