Text of Proposal/ Requested Action:	<i>Vibrio vulnificus</i> source states are those states reporting two (2) or more etiologically confirmed shellfish-borne <i>Vibrio vulnificus</i> illnesses in the previous five (5) years since 1995-traced to the consumption of commercially harvested raw or undercooked oysters that originated from the waters of that state.
Public Health Significance:	Currently there is no path for a state to be removed from the list of Illness Source States. The proposed change would alter the definition of <i>Vibrio vulnificus</i> Source State to remove states that have not had an illness for five (5) years.
