Public Health Significance:

In 2013 the ISSC Voting Delegates adopted Proposal 09-212 which requires training for harvesters and dealers. The Voting Delegates established an implementation date of January 1, 2014, for these training requirements. States are not prepared at this time to implement these requirements and a later implementation date is being

suggested.

Cost Information (if available):

Action by 2013 Task Force II Recommended no action on Proposal 13-224.

Rationale: Task Force II did not agree that a change to the implementation date was

appropriate.
