

## WANG GLOBALNET RECALLS FROZEN HALF SHELL OYSTERS

## DUE TO POSSIBLE HEALTH RISK

Dear Valued Customers.

Wang Globalnet of Vernon, CA is initiating a recall of 1,200 cases of Frozen Half Shell Oysters, specifically product KR-15-SP with a harvest date of 01/12/2025, due to a potential contamination with Norovirus.

Consumption of the affected product may cause symptoms such as diarrhea, stomach cramps, nausea, vomiting, fever, and chills. Symptoms typically appear approximately 12 hours after consuming contaminated shellfish and may last up to two days.

The recalled Frozen Half Shell Oysters were distributed in California, Utah, and other states.

These oysters were packaged in white corrugated boxes labeled "Frozen Half Shell Oysters, Product of Korea, Pack 144 counts," with a shellfish tag harvest date of 01/12/2025.

This recall was initiated following a notification from the California Department of Public Health regarding multiple reported illnesses in the state of Utah.

Customers who have purchased Frozen Half Shell Oysters (KR-15-SP, harvest date 01/12/2025) are strongly urged to return the product to the place of purchase for a full refund.
