## MEMORANDUM

RE: 2006-2007 Committee Charges

This memorandum is to confirm your appointment by the Conference Chairman to the 2006-2007 *Vibrio vulnificus* Subcommittee. The 2001 General Assembly of the ISSC voted to adopt Proposal 00-201 which outlined specific charges. The Vibrio Management Committee will provide oversight to the *Vibrio vulnificus* Subcommittee consistent with the direction established by the Conference's General Assembly.

In recent years a meeting of the *Vv* subcommittee has been scheduled in conjunction with the Spring Executive Board meeting. This year the *Vv* subcommittee will meet in conjunction with the Summer Executive Board meeting.

The charges listed below have been delegated to the *Vibrio vulnificus* Subcommittee. The VMC will work closely with the Subcommittee to accomplish these tasks.

- 1. Conduct the Vv work plan for the timeframe of January 1, 2006 December 31, 2006.
- 2. Continue to encourage industry-implemented post-harvest controls to reduce *Vv* levels. The Subcommittee is further charged to provide continued guidance to the states for promoting PHP and measures for determining PHP capacity.
- 3. Compile and review data on rates of illness.
- 4. Evaluate the effectiveness of collective reduction efforts in the year 2006.
- 5. Continue to evaluate the requirements in Section .04C to determine if changes in controls are necessary to achieve targeted illness reduction goals.
- 6. Review the progress on market and shelf life study efforts currently being conducted.
- 7. Continue to review the requirements of Model Ordinance Chapter 16 to determine appropriate controls for post harvest processing to address *Vv* reduction.

- 8. Continue to review the appropriateness of the minimum MPN level of *Vv* allowable for shellfish with labeling claims.
- 9. Review proposal 05-100, which addresses the *Vv* Risk Management Plan and Exemption for Licensed Shellfish Harvesters and Dealers. Recommendations should be made to the VMC prior to the 2007 Biennial Meeting.
- 10. Proposal 05-101 Establishment of a *Vv* Illness Review Subcommittee for action at the 2007 Biennial Meeting. Insert a new section in the *Vibrio* Management Plan for the creation of a working group to work collectively with the FDA and the CDC to review and approve all *Vibrio vulnificus* illness information, prior to it being presented to the *Vibrio vulnificus* Subcommittee.
- 11. Proposal 05-226 Maintenance Program for *Vibrio vulnificus* Risk Management Plan for Oysters for action by the Executive Board at its meeting August 2006. Modify Chapter II. @ .04 B. to include a collective illness reduction maintenance program which will state: States' compliance with the Plan will require States to maintain a minimum of 60% reduction in years subsequent to 2008. Determination and compliance after 2008 will be based on two-year averages beginning in 2009.
- 12. Resolution 05-100 Reevaluate the *Vibrio vulnificus* Risk Management Plan for Oysters unprecedented regulatory approach.
- 13. The Subcommittee is requested to discuss the appropriateness of the research recommended in 05-RN-201 Temperature Abused Oysters; 05-RN-202 New Economic Impacts Study of PHP of Oysters; 05-RN-203 Study of the Impact of CA Regulation.
