Charge 1:

Review and comment on the survey developed by the ISSC Executive Office.

Discussion: (Summary of discussion)

1a. The Committee reviewed the draft survey form developed by the ISSC Executive Office.

Discussion centered on the difference between a permit or license and an interstate shellfish shipper's certificate.

It was noted that in some states they are separate instruments and in others they are/or maybe one in the same.

The form was redesigned to ascertain the situation in each state and determine what statues, regulations and rules exist which govern the issuance, suspension and revocation of permits, interstate certificates or both, whether separated or combined in one instrument or procedure.

It was also felt that it would be useful to know what statutes, regulations, or rules existed pertaining to appeal by dealers of permit denials, revocations, or suspensions.

In all cases copies of such statutes, regulations and rules are requested along with specific citations of it for the various state shellfish control authority actions.
